

Please help these young women (and the many others) return to their families. Our hope remains in you. Amen.








How can you use this prayer in GB?

GB International is inviting members and friends to say this prayer on 14/15 April 2017, the third anniversary of the Chibok girls' abductions. However it can be used any time. There are a number of ways which you can use this prayer individually, in Girls' Brigade and in Church. Please feel free to adapt this prayer activity to suit the needs of your young people.



- Use it as part of your opening or closing devotions along with a brief update of the situation in Nigeria (see p.3). One person could read it out or you could print copies so the group can say it collectively together.
