Pray for strength, resilience and hope for all the people and communities affected by violence. In the midst of the unimaginable horror, pray that God will provide comfort, peace and love. For the 2 million displaced people, pray for calm and safety.

Survivors of violence

We are thankful for the return of 22 young women this year. Life is hard for many returning girls and women. Pray that communities and families would embrace them rather than stigmatise and ostracise them. Most need high quality long term care and rehabilitation. Pray that God would provide these resources.

Nigerian government

Pray for wisdom and discernment for President Buhari and his government. May they provide courageous and honest leadership during this time of violent conflict. Pray for peace to be restored to this nation.

Boko Haram

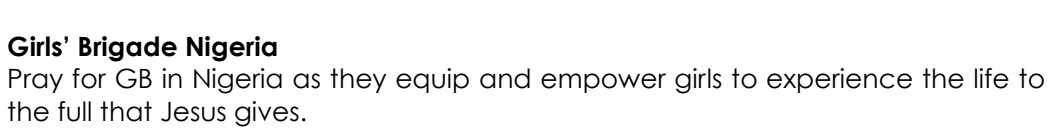
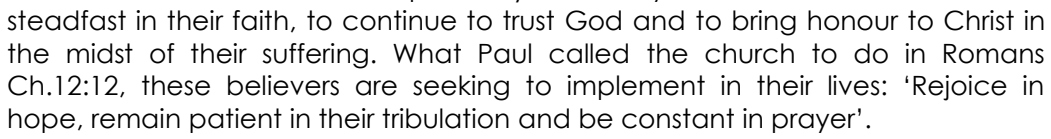
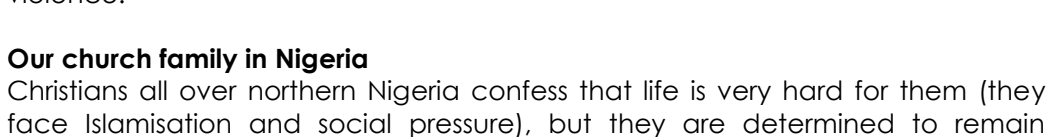
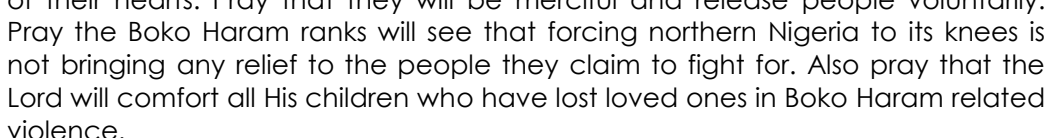
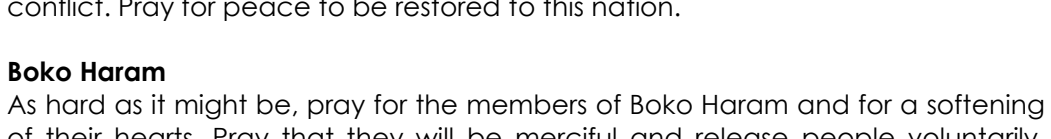
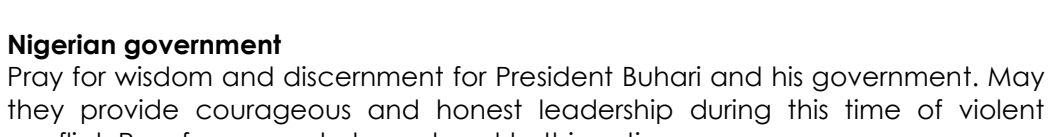
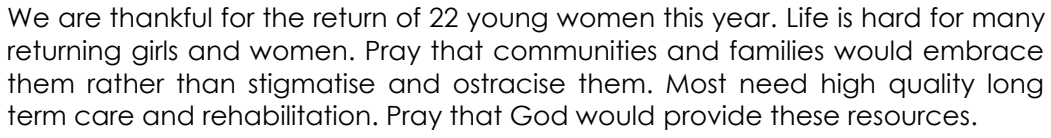
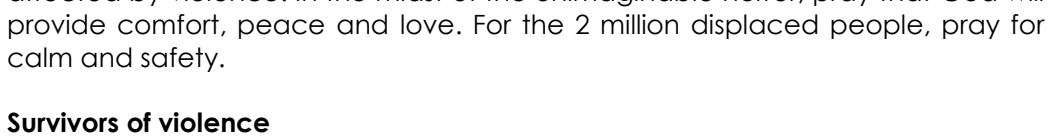
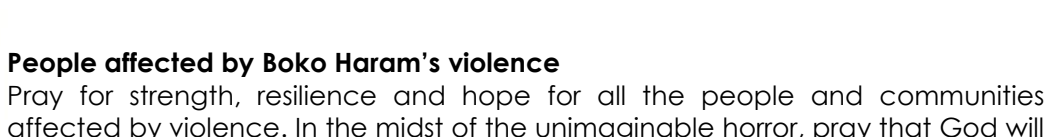

Christians all over northern Nigeria confess that life is very hard for them (they face Islamisation and social pressure), but they are determined to remain steadfast in their faith, to continue to trust God and to bring honour to Christ in the midst of their suffering. What Paul called the church to do in Romans Ch.12:12, these believers are seeking to implement in their lives: 'Rejoice in hope, remain patient in their tribulation and be constant in prayer'.
