



A new International President is due to be elected at the International Conference of Girls' Brigade 2018. Eligibility for the role, along with the remit of the International President, is documented in the 2010 International Rules and Procedures as follows:

The President shall be a committed Christian woman who has served on a National Council/Governing Body for at least three years and at International level for at least four years.

Remit of the International President

The International President shall:

- lead and chair all meetings of GBIC
- lead and chair the President's Committee
- lead the trustees of the charity in making decisions which will aid the forward movement of the organisation
- oversee the role of any staff within the International Office.

and the President shall lead the President's Committee in:

- setting key strategic direction for the growth and development of the ministry of The Girls' Brigade world wide
- sharing the vision and key messages of Girls' Brigade with the National Councils and Fellowships as well as with the worldwide church and connected bodies
- preserving the vision and integrity of The Girls' Brigade on behalf of GBIC
- ensuring legal and financial oversight of the charity
- developing relevant frameworks and principles which will enable us to work effectively in our diverse environments
- stimulating National Councils to engage with key issues facing the church and Christian ministry in their environment
- networking, when required and as agreed, with leaders of international bodies involved in children, youth, women's ministry and/or world evangelism.

Procedure for Nomination

All Member Countries are entitled to make a nomination, using the following procedure:

1. Seek the nominee's acceptance of nomination.
2. Obtain a completed CV form (attached) from the nominee.
3. Complete the nomination form (below) and return to home@gbworldwide.org by **28th February 2018** together with the CV form (attached).
4. Please note nominations will be acknowledge by the GBI team, by return email. If you do not receive a receipt acknowledgement within 7 days of sending your nomination, PLEASE CONTACT THE GBI TEAM AGAIN. **If we do not acknowledge the email it means that your nomination has not been lodged.**
5. A list of nominees received, with the nominees' CVs, will be circulated to all national teams by **31st May 2018**.
6. Nominees will be invited to speak at conference in Livingstone, Zambia, and time will be given for delegates to pray and consider their choice before voting.
7. Voting will take place at ICGB between **22nd- 27th July 2018**.
