



#### **International Competition 2018**

This year's international competition will focus on the hope that GB brings to those around us as we seek to enrich 'God's world.' We anticipate that the entries will be posted on our website and Facebook page to publicise GB. We hope to share many of your entries to help tell the story of GB's impact around the world.

#### **National Boards**

Now is the time to get your country involved - so please advertise the worldwide opportunity on your websites, social media and in your usual publications and mailings.

Each country may submit one entry to the international competition. If you have more than one submission you will need to decide internally how you will choose your country's entry. GBI will need to know your winning entry by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2018.

#### **Guidelines**

All GB companies are invited to submit entries following the guidelines below:

- 1. Choose a project, initiative or social action in which you have been involved which has blessed or enriched others e.g.**
  - raising the profile of a social injustice issue
  - involvement in a social enterprise project
  - working with a vulnerable group
  - engagement with a local charity
- 2. Tell us the story of your involvement using power point with a maximum of 10 slides.**
- 3. Music, animations or short video inserts may be embedded**
- 4. The total running time of the power point slide show should not exceed 2 minutes.**
- 5. All photos and videos should be high resolution so that they can be used on our website. We recommend that Photos should be 300dpi and videos M4 format.**
- 6. Those in photos or videos must have parental consent for their images to be publicised.**

#### **Submission of entries**

- 1. Power points should be titled as follows: Fellowship – Country – Company/Group Name (e.g. Asia-India-1<sup>st</sup> Delhi)**
- 2. All entries should be submitted to your national board as determined locally**
- 3. A copy of your entry and any supporting files should be sent to GBI via <https://wetransfer.com/> using the [home@gbworldwide.org](mailto:home@gbworldwide.org) address.**
- 4. National Boards should inform GBI of their winning entry by emailing the title (e.g. Asia- India – 1<sup>st</sup> Delhi) to [home@gbworldwide.org](mailto:home@gbworldwide.org) by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2018**
- 5. Judging will be based on the story you are telling rather than technical excellence.**
- 6. Judging will take place at ICGB 2018 where the winner will be announced.**
- 7. Any entries, not just the winners, may be used by GB in your country or GBI in promotions and publicity.**
