For those countries where there is no Zambian Embassy, please let us know immediately so we can begin to make arrangements for you to be given a Visa on arrival at the Airport

Health: Make sure you travel with appropriate health insurance.

Check local guidelines regarding vaccinations required: this will depend on where you are travelling from.

- ✓ Most will need to take prescription medicine before, during, and after your trip to prevent malaria.
- ✓ Most travellers will need: routine vaccinations: MMR, DTaP plus Typhoid and Hepatitis A
- ✓ Some Travellers: will also require Hepatitis B, Rabies, Cholera and Yellow Fever

Food: Unless you have indicated on your registration for a special diet, the hotel will serve a pretty diverse platter that should be ok for everyone!

Cultural information: Most people speak English in Zambia, so communication is pretty easy. Livingstone is a cosmopolitan city so you will find it friendly

Climate: July is winter for us and temperatures could be as low as 14 degrees, so please pack a jersey to keep yourself warm especially in the evenings.

Clothing: Light warm clothing is advised; pack some walking shoes for the day out.

- ✓ Full uniform: (adapted if necessary for the climate) to be worn to opening worship, the AGM and closing worship
- ✓ Conference wear: to be determined by each country and to be worn to conference sessions
- ✓ Please bring your cultural dress to wear on the last evening
- ✓ Conference T-shirts will be provided and will be worn on our day out (please submit size as below)

Currency: There are ATMs and you should be able to change your money in the bank. The currency of Zambia is Kwacha and the exchange rate fluctuates between 9Kwacha to 10Kwacha to a dollar

Arrival: Provided you send us your arrival details in good time, we will be there to meet you at the airport and take you to the hotel.

Final Payment: Final payments were due by 28th February 2018. Please ensure any outstanding payments are made as soon as possible.

Sightseeing: We have arranged for everyone to go the Musi-o-tunia (Victoria) Falls, the museum as well as the water front for visitation.

Early Arrivals: For those coming in early please arrange your own programme or you can contact Catherine Chipungu, ICGB organising committee member and Livingstone resident, catherinechipungu@yahoo.com who may be able to help you organise some sightseeing.

Safari Trip: For those staying on, we are working at organising a safari. The negotiations are taking longer than we expected, but we want to get the best deal for you. We are looking at a walking safari in the Game Park, bungee jumping, mkuni cultural village visit and helicopter flight over the Musi-o-tunya falls.
