### For our members facing climate issues

For *GB Keyna* who are facing months of heavy rain and subsequent devastating floods leading to displacement of many people, including GB members.

For *GB Philippines* who are facing extreme heat leading to the suspension of many activities and a significant impact on its harvest.

For our island nations such as *GB Antigua* and *GB St Maarten* throughout this year's hurricane season.

### Africa

#### *Ghana*

Give thanks for the transformation of girls' lives through sponsorship for vocational and technical skills training for future employment

Pray for the ongoing refurbishment of the National Empowerment Training Institute and Social Support Resource Centre to enable skills training. Pray for successful national council elections at the upcoming conference.



#### *Kenya*

Give thanks for the impact the gospel is having in the lives of the girls they serve; in the creation of responsible servant leaders who work with integrity.

Pray for ongoing financial challenges both locally and nationally. Pray for national leaders as they review its' structure to ensure GB can face contemporary challenges.

#### *Malawi*

Give thanks for the provision of land which can be developed for use by GB and rented out to the wider public to generate income.

Pray for resources to facilitate the construction of buildings on their land. Pray for leaders as they seek to develop programmes and activities to engage its' young women, particularly those aged over 25.

### *Nigeria*

Give thanks for the development of work in schools as a new ministry. Give thanks for the collaboration with media houses to increase the reach of GB.

Pray for resolution to issues of national insecurity and whilst ongoing for protection of members of leaders, with the resulting financial challenges and the difficulties in physical meeting.

### *Seirra Leone*

Give thanks for participation in the Africa Fellowship Conference for the first time. Give thanks for the ability to organise and pay for practical skills training in topics such as bead making and cooking.

Pray for officers as they develop programmes to capture the attention of girls and young women to increase engagement. Pray for a space to carry out central activities such as camps, seminars etc.

### *South Africa*

Give thanks for continued involvement in the local community such as participation in beach cleans, participation in community prayer walks and events to tackle period poverty.

Pray for the leaders and members at all levels as they face the challenges of their culture such as poverty, drug abuse and violence.

### *Tanzania*

Give thanks for the lives of those transformed by the provision of tailoring skills.

Pray for the growth of GB throughout the country. Pray for the ability to host a national conference for girls.

### *Zambia*

Give thanks for the outreach into local communities through both practical provision such as food donations and through evangelism.

Pray for the resources and partnerships to enable the completion of a multipurpose skills and training centre.

### *Zimbabwe*

Give thanks for the impact girls are having in their local communities through involvement in climate change awareness campaigns and clean-up events.

Pray for the growth of GB throughout the country. Pray for the officers and volunteers; that they would have continued passion to see the lives of girls transformed in the face of challenges.

## **Asia**

### *Hong Kong*

Give thanks for the opportunities to share the gospel with girls and young women.

Pray for staff and volunteers to come forward to facilitate the work of GB. Pray for closer relationships between all levels of the organisation in order to create and maintain greater support networks.



### *Malaysia*

Give thanks for the outreach into new communities, including the indigenous populations (the “Orang Asli”) with the subsequent creation of a new company.

Pray for relationships between the schools who run GB companies, the teachers in charge and for the local churches for support them so that GB activities can be carried out smoothly.

### *Philippines*

Pray for the national executive elections taking place in June and for those who are elected, in their leadership journeys.

## *Singapore*

Give thanks for the ability to outreach and help many local vulnerable people through the “GB Friend in Deed” programme. Give thanks for the formation of partnerships to help GB tackle sensitive social needs such as homelessness.

Pray for the opening of doors to be able to carry out activities in schools and other public spaces.

## *Thailand*

Give thanks for the return to normal annual activities such as national camps following COVID-19. Give thanks for increasing involvement of members within their local communities.

Pray for leadership succession. Pray for the ongoing ministry work within Thailand as they celebrate their 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2024-2025.

## **Caribbean and Americas**

### *Antigua*

Pray for the leaders of the nations as they meet at the Small Island Developing States Meeting held in Antigua; that they will seek God’s guidance in decision making. Pray for the members and leaders as they face the challenges of gender inequality; that they will have transformational voices in their communities.



### *Bahamas*

Pray for girls and young women; that they will be filled with the hope of God’s promises and be strengthened in the face of peer pressure that affects their mental health. Pray for members and leaders; that they will have a renewed sense of dedication for the work of GB and spreading the gospel.

### *British Virgin Islands*

Pray for our members; that they will increase in number and that dormant companies could reopen. Pray for our leaders; that they will feel God working in personal struggles such as with grief, and that they will have a renewed passion for the work of GB.

### *Cayman Islands*

Pray for our girls; that they may feel part of a family and not alone. Pray for our members and officers; that each day their faith may grow stronger despite the many challenges they face.

### *Jamaica*

Pray for members and their families as they face issues of violence. Pray for girls and women to be raised up into leadership through all levels of the organisation.

### *St Maarten*

Pray for growth in numbers; for the revival of dormant companies and for the opening of new groups. Pray for the raising up of young leaders to carry on the work of GB in years to come.

### *Trinidad and Tobago*

Give thanks for the ability to support members in their lives outside of GB e.g. through assisting with school supplies.

Pray for the raising up of dedicated officers and helpers. Pray for leaders as they seek to develop activities to engage girls of all ages.

## **Europe**

### *England and Wales*

Give thanks for the inclusivity of GB, which has a transformational impact in lives of its members regardless of their medical or educational needs. Give thanks for the impact the skills learnt in GB can have on the local community.

Pray for ongoing sustainability; for growth in members and volunteers.



### *Northern Ireland*

Give thanks for an increase in participation in competitions, camps, leadership training and Queen's Award in the past year. Give thanks for new partnerships with other organisations and the engagement of girls in the opportunities these provide.

Pray for leaders; for their refreshment over the summer break and for wisdom as they plan programmes and events for the coming year.

### *Scotland*

Pray for leaders over the summer break; that the summer break will offer opportunity for rest and recharging, that their enthusiasm and passion will be rekindled for the opportunities GB has to offer members. Pray for growth in numbers to increase the reach of the good news of Jesus.

## **Pacific**

### *Australia*

Give thanks for a partnership with GLS Next Gen, helping teenage members and young leaders in their faith journeys.
